THE STORY

Tomah Schools commit to energy efficiency; save over \$100,000 in energy costs

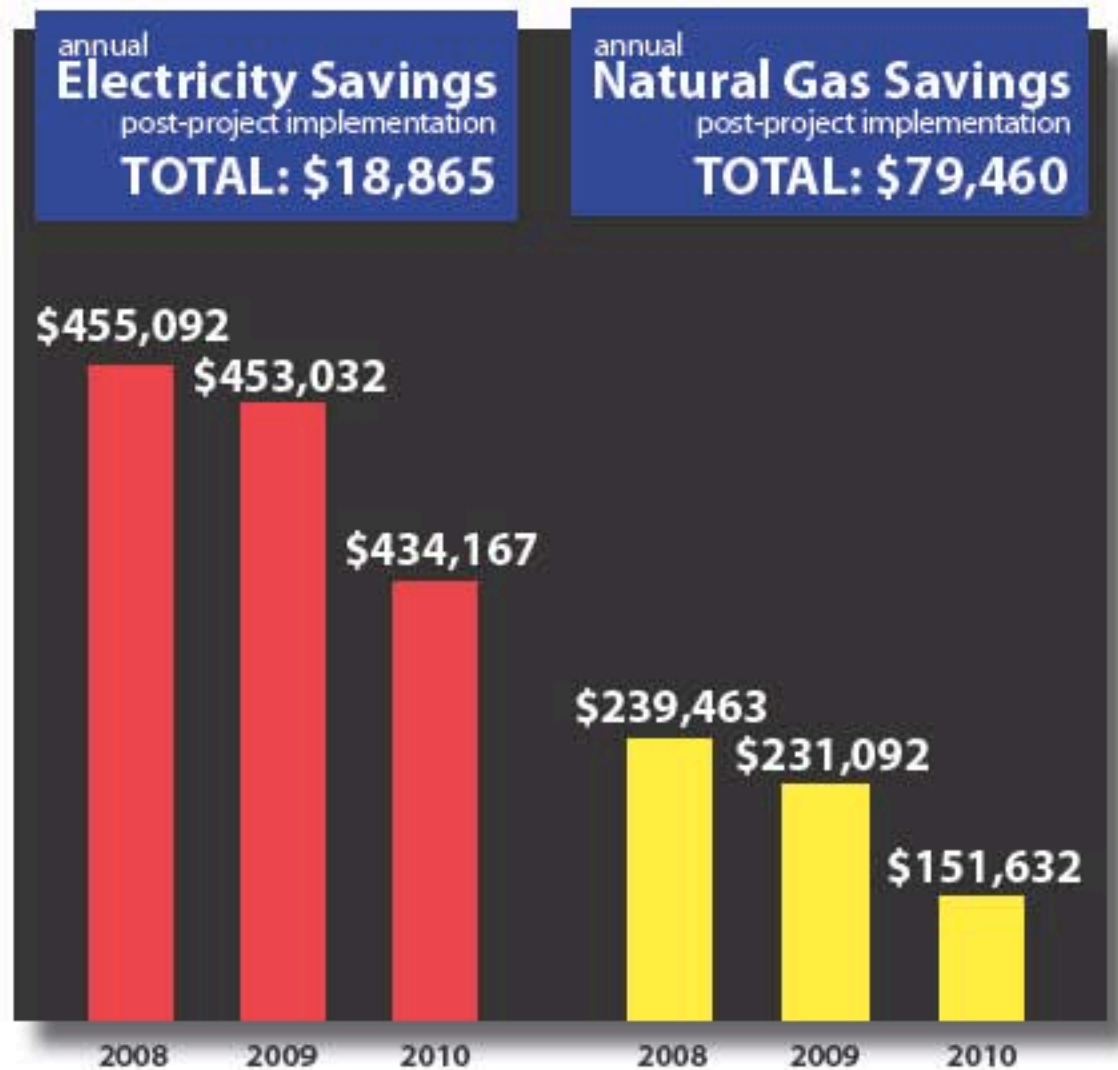
Tomah School District Business Manager Greg Gaarder knew he needed to reduce his district's operational costs. He also knew that optimizing the energy efficiency of the district's facilities was the answer to reducing those costs. In order to initiate these changes, Gaarder sought the help of the Complete Control Energy Management Team. Complete Control energy specialists executed an energy audit on 14 district facilities and then implemented the energy reduction plan changes in order to make those facilities more energy efficient. The result: the district dropped their annual natural gas and electric energy costs by a combined total of \$98,325.97. With the addition of Focus on Energy incentives, the district saved an another \$30,106.74, for a total annual savings of \$128,432.71.
